Subject: School participation in 'National Deworming Day' program reg.


The Government of India is committed towards a worm-free future for the children of India. In order to reduce the load of intestinal worm and related morbidity in the country, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare with support from Ministry of Women & Child Development and Department of School Education & Literacy under Ministry of Human Resource Development has initiated National Deworming Day (NDD) all over the country, where all children from 1-19 years of age are given deworming tablet through the platform of schools and anganwadi centers.

The NDD round will be implemented across the country during February 2018. A detailed NDD toolkit containing operational guidelines, monitoring checklists, FAQs and Factsheets is uploaded on National Health Mission's website. All Heads of school affiliated to CBSE are required to ensure effective implementation and increased coverage of the program.

The following steps are suggested for effective coverage of targeted children with deworming tablets during the NDD round:

1. On February 10, 2018, ensure that all children of your school (1-19 years of age) chew deworming tablet (Albendazol 400mg) as per instruction given on National Health Mission's website: <http://nhm.gov.in/nrhmc-components/rmnc-h-a / child-health-immunization / national-deworming-day-2016 / national-deworming-day-february-2018.html>
2. If any child cannot chew deworming tablet on 10 February, 2018; then please ensure that they chew deworming tablet on the 'mop-up day' on 15 February, 2018.
