WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 5th June 2014

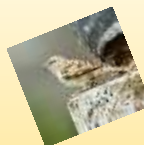


World Environment Day (WED) is the United Nations' principal vehicle for encouraging worldwide awareness and action for the environment. WED is the 'people's day' for doing something positive by pulling together individual endeavor into collective energy that infuses a renewed support for environmental conservation. The activities conducted in schools, whether they are organizing clean-up campaigns, food waste reduction initiatives, walk-to-school or participating in walkathons or marathon races, banning plastic use in the school premises, conducting 'art-from-waste' exhibits, tree-planting campaigns, cultural programmes, literary competitions, recycling initiatives, social media campaigns - every activity adds up. When multiplied, individual actions result in a positive, collective impact. Also, celebrating WED would be an excellent opportunity to raise a call for solidarity with island nations that are at the greatest risk from rising sea levels due to climate change.

LET'S TAKE PART IN SOME OF THESE ECO-EVENTS TOGETHER!

Classes I to V:

- Tree-planting as a group activity
- Essay-writing in about 200 words :
Sparrow: a beautiful and social creature .
- Students may put bird feeders in their garden and water bowls during summer.
- Put up the pictures of important birds/medicinal plants on the display board



House Sparrow, one of the most commonly found bird is on decline as shown by its decreasing numbers and need to be protected. On this WED 2014, let us be more sensitized to the plight of this friendly bird, along with other environmental concerns.

Classes VI to VIII

- Essay writing in about 300 words on: **Causes and effects of global warming.**
- Poster-making on the theme: **Sparrows**, with a slogan on how to protect them.
- An elocution competition [3 minutes per speaker] on :**Conserve Sparrows to save biodiversity**
- A class discussion on: **Helping the environment by reducing waste.**

Classes IX to XII

- A seminar on: **Ways to enhance natural resilience against climate change.**

- A debate on: **Mobile towers must be removed as they have caused the decline of sparrow population.**
- A cleanliness campaign in the school, and chalk out a plan to recycle waste produced in the campus for the whole year.
