The objective of the JENESYS programme is to deepen mutual understanding among young people and to lay foundation for future bond among the youths in Asian and Oceanian Countries along with mutual understanding and friendship. The programme is meant to establish basis of Asia's stalwart solidarity through various exchange programmes.

CBSE proposes to nominate 350 students and 30 teachers for the above cited programme. The Principals of the schools affiliated to CBSE are requested to nominate students for each category (only one boy and one girl except soccer) and one teacher from their schools giving the required details for processing at this end.

Selection Criteria:

- One student must not be nominated for more than one category.
- The students must be in the age group of 14-18 years (studying in classes IX to XII).
- They must be physically fit to undertake field trips and tours in Japan.
- They must be mentally agile and be creative enough to interact with other students and participate in debates etc.
- Being the representatives of the youth of our country they are expected to be highly disciplined upholding values of punctuality and adherence to rules and regulations. It is further emphasized that they should abstain from smoking and drinking.
- The students so selected should have either applied for or should be holding a passport. Preference may be given to those schools from which students had not participated in the earlier JENESYS programme including students from SC/ST/OBC category.
- Preference may not be given to those students who have already visited abroad either in sponsored or private visit.
