Subject: Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign 2019

Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) Campaign 2019 was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 11th September which aims to reinforce '**sanitation as everyone's business**' and is focused on **plastic waste management** as its key theme. It seeks to intensify the momentum with encouraging the masses to undertake shramdaan (voluntary activities) for Swachhata.

In this regard, School Heads are requested to participate in SHS 2019 on **20th September 2019**. The schools can take up the following suggestive activities in an extensive manner:

1. Mobilize all students to undertake shramdaan by collecting plastic waste from and around the school campus. The school must ensure for the safe disposal of the plastic waste collected thereafter.
2. Take up awareness campaigns to limit the use of **Single Use Plastic** (such as plastic bag, plastic cutlery, styrofoam cups and cutlery, etc.) and publicize the use of alternatives to Single Use Plastic by making use of all publicity sites, platforms and other outreach formats available to the school, including the social media space and regional media.
3. Display the logo of Swachhata Hi Seva along with messages against Single Use Plastic use, in and around campus premises to generate maximum awareness.
