
Reference: EE.1 Section's note of even no. dated 11th October, 2019 and 24th October, 2019.

This is regarding Celebration of Constitution day on 26th November, 2019 and subsequent activities culminating in 'Dr. Ambedkar Jayanti' on 14th April, 2020.

2. It is requested to kindly issue necessary instructions to all the States/ UTs/ Autonomous Organizations falling under the administrative control of your Bureau/ Division to issue appropriate directions to all the Schools and Regional Subordinate Offices to observe Constitution Day on 26th November, 2019. Following activities may be conducted between 26.11.2019 and 14.04.2020:

- i. Pledge taking ceremony to mark the occasion. Special Assembly may be organized in all Schools where the Pledge may be read out.
- ii. Debates, essay competitions, cultural programs, quiz competitions, seminars and lectures etc. may be held at State, District and School levels.
- iii. National level essay, debate and quiz competitions on Fundamental Duties and themes related to Constitution may be organized across the country, the winners at State and National levels may be suitably rewarded.
- iv. Reading of Preamble and Fundamental Duties.
- v. Organizing Mock Parliament.
- vi. Public messages on Fundamental Duties for dissemination among students and staff during the celebrations. Brochures, pamphlets and e-posters on Fundamental Duties may be prepared in Hindi, English and regional languages and distributed in Schools among students.
- vii. Effective utilization of Government/ Organization websites and MyGov platform to encourage citizen centric activities on the prescribed theme. Students may be encouraged to participate in online quiz/ Olympiad competitions being organized by MyGov.
- viii. Invite eminent personalities from different walks of life to disseminate the message of Fundamental Duties.
- ix. Talks by eminent lawyers and legal scholars on Fundamental Duties and related themes may be organized in Schools.

3. It is also requested to kindly prepare a Calendar of Activities, including all the above activities, starting from Constitution Day (26.11.2019) and culminating in Dr. Ambedkar Jayanti/ Samrasta Divas (14.04.2020), with greater focus on Fundamental Duties and furnish the same to EE.1 Section by 31.10.2019 positively (e-mail id: coordinationee1@gmail.com).
