Subject: Industry Engagement & Technology Exposure Program for CBSE students

In continuation to CBSE Circular No. 101/2022 dated 09.09.2022, CBSE in partnership with Microsoft shall be offering the next batches of Industry Engagement & Technology Exposure Program for students across CBSE schools. Microsoft through its Global Learning Partners would be conducting various virtual sessions on technology exposure and industry engagement for students during **November and December 2022**.

Brief about the program:

- Students will be oriented about various themes such as technology areas, inspiring industry talks, career insights, entrepreneurship and hands-on exposure to implement their ideas. Students would have opportunities to work on mini projects as teams. They will submit their projects at the end of the program.
- Mini challenges and assignments will be provided to students during the program for continuous assessment and engagement.

- Leaders from the industry will be invited to deliver guest talks on each day of the program

Themes to be covered:

- Entrepreneurship - from idea to making it happen
- Implementing innovative ideas

Mode and Duration:

- Online (virtual)
- Five days, two hours per day and time for project work and showcase
