Subject: Celebration of Har Ghar Tiranga 2025 - reg.

Dear Principal

The 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign has been started under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav to encourage people to bring the Tiranga home and to hoist it to mark India's independence. The objective of this campaign is to encourage citizens to hoist the national flag at their homes and build a personal and emotional connection with the Tiranga.

This year, Har Ghar Tiranga campaign will be organized from 2<sup>nd</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025 in the following three phases.

(i) Phase I - 2<sup>nd</sup> August to 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 (ii) Phase II - 9<sup>th</sup> August to 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2025

(iii)Phase III - 13<sup>th</sup> August to 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2025

Activities to be undertaken in all three phases are at Annexure-1.

- You are requested to encourage students in your schools to hoist the Indian National Flag
  in their homes and upload their selfies with Tiranga on the website
  www.harghartiranga.com during the campaign. While displaying the National Flag, the

Activities such as Selfie with Tiranga, Prabhat-pheris, Tiranga Rallies (including bike and cycle rallies), Tiranga exhibitions, along with other grassroots-level Janbhagidari initiatives may also be undertaken to make Independence Day celebrations 2025 a more participative and widely celebrated occasion across the country.

#### Activities to be undertaken in all three phases

### Phase I (2<sup>nd</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> August 2025):

- · Decorating school walls and boards with Tiranga inspired art.
- Organizing Tiranga Rangoli competitions across schools.
- Organizing Tiranga Rakhi making workshops and competition in coordination with the Department of Posts for facilitating to dispatch the rakhis to soldiers and police personnels.
- To orgainse letter-writing activities where students write messages to soldier and police personnel, acknowledge their dedication and to the nation. These letters may be collected in bulk and handed over to the local postal authorities. School Principals concerned may contact the postal Department in the district.
- Encouraging students to participate in national quiz on the Tiranga via the MyGov platform in coordination with MeitY (MyGov).
- Display of exhibitions provided by Ministry of Culture (available in download section of website <a href="https://www.harghartiranga.com">www.harghartiranga.com</a>) in your school.
- Sharing pictures on social media with #harghartiranga2025.
- Encouring students to volunteer for Har Ghar Tiranga and spread awareness by motivating families to host the national flag and upload selfies. The campaign website provides volunteer registration details. Top 10 volunteers may be invited to attend Independence Day celebrations on 15th August.

### Phase II (9th -12th August 2025):

Organizing local Tiranga rallies or yatras, involving students in holding long tricoloured fabrics or flag while marching in and around schools.


### Phase III (13th -15th August 2025):
