Laser: Hair follicles are targeted by the laser that passes a pulsating light beam through the skin. Manicure & Pedicure: Treatment for grooming one's hand and feet, manicure is the treatment for improving the appearance of hand and nails, this is a treament leads to nail growth, pushed back cuticles, preventing minor skin conditions. Whereas, pedicure helps in improving the appearance of the feet and toenails. Removes dead skin cells using pimice stone, massage, exfoliation</p> <p>2. Threading: A technique of hair removal by using a cotton thread. Pulls out the hair be twisting motion which traps the hair and take it out</p> <p>3: Waxing: Hair removal technique by using hot/cold wax, it is of two types- strip waxing and stripless waxing</p> <p>4. Make up: Process of applying cosmetics to enhance or alter the appearance, uses lipsticks, eye liner, eye shadow, kohl, lip balm, concealer, foundation, mascara, etc...</p> <p>7. Hairdo: Way in which hair is styled. Hairstyle is achieved in certain way by using combs, blow dryer, few cosmetics, etc.</p>				
Q.24	<p>Threading techniques to suit male clients. Explain</p> <p>Ans. 1. Shaping the beard: done by trimming the excess or long hair and defining the edge of the beard. Electric razors, scissors or epilators can be used for the same, threading and hot wax can be used to remove random and stray hairs</p> <p>2. Nose hair removal: difficult using scissor or a razor but waxing is a convenient and effective method, small amount of wax is put at the opening with the help of a stick, allowed to cool and harden and then pulled taking along the nose hair.</p> <p>3. ear hair removal: hard wax is put on the ear and allowed to cool and harden then pulled off.
