#. Limboo Language is spoken by the Limboos of Sikkim and West Bengal in India. It is also spoken in Nepal, Hongkong, U.K. and so on.

#. West Sikkim has the highest Limboo population and speakers as well.

#. In India, there are 40,835 speakers out of which Sikkim has the highest number of speakers i.e. 38,733 followed by West Bengal with 921 and Assam has 780 speakers (Census 2011)

#. It belongs to Tibeto-Burman language family.

#. It is taught upto Master Level in Sikkim University.
