Prescribed book: Russian for children Book VI, lessons 6 - 10

(A) Listening and Speaking Skills in Russian - Students should be given practice 10 in interpreting small texts/ sentences from Russian into English and vice versa. At the end of the year they may be evaluated on their speaking and listening skills in Russian. (10 marks)
