- Conclusion
- Acknowledgements
- o References (References may be quoted in the text by superscripting)
- o Abstract (Not more than 250 words)
- ➤ Word limit for the article is **2500-3000 words**
- > The article should be submitted as a single file in MS WORD format
- All submissions should be accompanied by a biographical note of not more than 100 words
