Registration on the Web Portal 'National Youth Parliament Scheme'

Hon'ble President launched the Web – Portal of National Youth Parliament Scheme on the occasion to commemorate the 70th Anniversary of adoption of the Constitution of India 'SamvidhanDiwas' on 26th November 2019 in Central Hall, Parliament House, New Delhi. All educational institutions can access the portal at www.nyps.mpa.gov.in to take part in the Youth Parliament programme. The registration for the current session is open till 31st January 2020. The salient features of the web – portal are:

- All recognized educational institutions of the country are eligible to participate in the programme.
- The registration for participation will be done by the educational institutions through the web portal.
- E-training modules, videos, photographs and scripts are available on the portal for online self learning of the participants.
- After successful registration, the educational institutions will be able to conduct youth parliament sitting in their respective institutions.
- Each student taking part in the sitting will get a Digital 'Certificate of Participation' and Teacher incharge ad Head of Institution will get a 'Certificate of Appreciation' through the web portal.

The schools affiliated to the Board may register and actively participate in the Scheme.
