Young Warrior NXT Bot to engage students in activities to impart life skills & employability skills

This is in continuation to CBSE Circular no. 33/2021, Notification no. 51/2021 and Circular no. 64/2021 regarding the Young Warrior Movement, where CBSE collaborated with UNICEF & YuWaah. The movement engaged over 6.6 million young people to take action against COVID-19. Thanks to all the teachers and students who actively took part and became Young Warrior.

CBSE now invites all teachers, students, and staff members to participate in the Young Warrior NXT program which aims to impart essential life & employability skills to young people between the ages of 14-24. To start with, young people are encouraged to register themselves on Chat Bot which interacts in a fun and interactive way and enable learnings. Users can learn skills such as Problem Solving, Self-Awareness, Communication, Collaboration, as well as work on job-readiness and stress management, through easy to do tasks on this interactive bot. The tasks are self-driven and all participants who complete atleast 10 tasks out of the total 20 tasks will be issued a <u>certificate of completion</u> jointly by CBSE, YuWaah, and UNICEF.


