- Equip teachers to be able to help students develop skills such as problem-solving, critical thinking, creativity, and teamwork.



Duration:

The duration of the programme will be of five days. The programme is scheduled from 2nd - 6th May, 2023 i.e. Tuesday to Saturday.

Mode of training:

There will be classroom sessions along with other activities and exercises during the training programme. The training programme would be conducted at the Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad campus.

Pedagogy:

The program would be delivered by a mix of experts, EDII faculty and industry's renowned professionals. There will be:

- Lecture-cum discussion sessions for thorough interactions among the participants.
- Interaction with experts in entrepreneurship development, curriculum development, pedagogy, opportunity guidance, etc.
- Case studies, role plays, & simulation exercises.
- Group based Assignments, experience sharing and presentations/practice sessions.
- Interaction with successful entrepreneurs for practical insights.

Expected Outcome:

The expected outcome of a school teacher's development program in entrepreneurship mentoring is to equip the teacher with the knowledge, skills, and resources necessary to foster a culture of entrepreneurship among students and support them in their journey towards becoming successful entrepreneurs.

- 02 The teacher will have an ability to identify and nurture entrepreneurial talent.
- 03 The teacher will be able to develop methods that promote entrepreneurial thinking, problem-solving, and innovation in students.
- 04 The teacher will be able to work effectively with other teachers, mentors, and business leaders to support students in their entrepreneurial endeavors.
- 05 The teacher's efforts will lead to increased student interest in entrepreneurship, as well as greater motivation to pursue entrepreneurial opportunities.
- 06 The teacher will be able to create a supportive environment that encourages students to take risks, learn from failure, and persist in their pursuits.

The participants for the training programme are School Teachers and Representatives of Schools who are interested in building their knowledge on entrepreneurship and imparting education to the school students on entrepreneurship and Entrepreneurial Mindset.
