These visits are intended to provide school principals with first-hand exposure to best practices adopted by leading institutions, facilitate potential collaborations for strengthening the integration of Skill (Vocational) Education into mainstream schooling, and acquaint participants with emerging trends and innovations through interactive and experiential learning opportunities.

CBSE will reimburse Travelling Allowance (TA) and Daily Allowance (DA) up to ₹10,000 or the actual expenditure incurred, whichever is lower, to Principals of Government and Private Independent Schools, subject to the submission of certified hard copies of original bills and supporting documents.

Reimbursement shall be admissible for only one Exposure Visit per Principal during an academic year. Principals who have not participated in any previous CBSE Exposure Visit shall be given preference for participation. further, Principals who have already attended a CBSE Exposure Visit in any previous year shall not be eligible for TA/DA reimbursement.

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Participation in the Exposure Visit shall be confirmed only after receipt of an official confirmation email from CBSE. The claim for TA/DA reimbursement, along with certified hard copies of the original bills, supporting documents, and a one-page report on the Exposure Visit, must be submitted within 10 days from the date of completion of the visit. Claims received after the stipulated period or submitted through email/electronic mode shall not be considered.
