Participation is subject to prior email confirmation. TA/DA bills, along with supporting documents and a one-page visit report, must be submitted in hard copy within 10 days of completion of the visit. The bills submitted late or electronically will not be accepted.

Participants nominated for the exposure visit may book their air or train tickets only through Ashok Travels and Tours, Balmer Lawrie & Company Ltd, or IRCTC otherwise reimbursement of airfare/ train fare will not be entertained.
