Gurungs are compassionate people, who support each other, are sociable and often enjoy dancing. Musical Instrument is played in celebrations of a community. And also more prevalent, the Tungna folk instrument of the Gurung community is played during winter drives into the mountains and high hills with *falgi*-prepared from *makai*/maize. They used to carry and eat *falgi* while herding sheep in the Himalayas during winter. This *falgi* used to be their daily meal in the Himalayas. This Tungna folk instrument of the Gurung community is made of Sheep *andra/titay*/intestine after being dried and made a string.
